NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CANCEL REGISTRATION

TAKE NOTICE, that it is the Commission's intention to cancel the registration of the political party after the expiry of 21 days from the date of service of this notice on you.

The grounds for the proposed cancellation are:

Section A – Conviction of an Offence

The party has been convicted of an offence under the Organic Law or any other law which carries a fine of K1,000.00 or more and the party has failed to pay the fine imposed on it within the time limit fixed by the Court imposing the fine for payment of the fine.

Section B – Conviction of an Offence under Sections 79 and 81 of the Organic Law

The party or a member of the party has been convicted of:-

The party has without reasonable justification failed to file financial returns as required by the Organic Law, for two consecutive years (specify which years and the nature of returns not submitted).

You are given 21 days to take steps to ensure compliance with the Organic Law.

Note: Provide all other materials including documentation, which forms the basis upon which the grounds for cancellation are founded.

You are therefore required, within a period of not less than 21 days from the date of service of this notice on you, to show cause to the Commission as to why the registration of the party as a registered political party should not be cancelled.
