PART IV DECLARATION OF ELECTORAL EXPENDITURE

The particulars set out in each account and receipts are to be sufficient to allow the nature of expenditure to be clearly identified. A sample of each item or printed election material and the text of each radio and television advertisement must be attached.

The “Date or period of expenditure incurred” means the day or period during which the advertisement was broadcast or published or the material was printed. It does NOT mean the date the account was paid unless payment was made on the day of the obligation to pay arose.
