- the name of the party is obscene or offensive; or
- the name of the party so closely resembles the name of a registered political party or public body so as is likely to be confused with or mistaken for that registered political party or public body;

you are invited to submit to the Registrar, by (**specify date**) a statement setting out the grounds for objections. This statement should be in Form 6 or on the appropriate form (as determined by the Registrar) and include your name, address and signature.
